BACKGROUND

Children are often dropped off at Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre and left for extended periods of time unsupervised. Therefore, to address the safety concerns related to this practice, the JBRSEC will be implementing the following policy.

POLICY STATEMENT

This policy was implemented for the safety and well-being of all users, while participating in or attending events as a spectator at Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre.

POLICY

All children 14 years of age and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult, 18 years of age or older, unless participating in on-ice activities.

This policy will be clearly posted with the other established regulations for activities and placed at the entrance of Jack Byrne Regional Sport & Entertainment Centre.

POLICY REVIEW: This policy will be reviewed a year after implementation, however, it may be subject to change following new experience or knowledge.
