- (1) We will have available the following pieces of equipment for snow clearing

- (2) It is understood and agreed that we will be responsible for all damages to buildings, pavement, curbs, sidewalks, posts, lighting standards, etc that is caused by the operation of snow clearing equipment.

- (3) The following documents are enclosed with the quotation:

- (a) Insurance coverage for a minimum of \$2,000,000. Proof of coverage in the form of a letter from Insurance Provider is required.
- (b) Registration with the Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Commission. Proof of registration in the form of a "Letter of Good Standing" is required.

- (4) I have read the contents of this quotation document. It is understood and agreed that the terms of this agreement shall be in effect for two (2) Winter seasons. This agreement shall come into effect on November 30, 2018 Winter season and will continue until the end of the Winter Season until April 15th, 2020.

SNOWCLEARING

- (1) The Contractor will be required to keep readily available adequate equipment capable of doing the required work in a timely manner.
A detailed list of equipment must be declared.
If, in the opinion of JBRSEC the equipment listed is not adequate to do the required work, the quote shall be deemed as not meeting the specifications and will be rejected.
- (2) The Contractor shall clear all snow from the parking lot, parking lot entrance and the Ice Resurfacer entrance, including snow removed from the ice surface.
- (3) Snow clearing must commence whenever there is an accumulation of 25mm (1") or more of snow or when wind conditions cause drifting to such a degree that it will impede the smooth flow of traffic.
- (4) When overnight snowfalls or drifting occurs to such a degree to warrant snow clearing, then all areas are to be cleared no later than 06:00am on Saturday and Sunday and 08:00am on weekdays.
- (5) The contractor must plow snow to the extremities of all areas being cleared in order to utilize all on-site parking.
- (6) Snow shall be cleared in a manner to avoid leaving a buildup of any snow or ice. Any such buildup of snow or ice left on the cleared areas, corners, entrances and exits is to be removed at no cost to JBRSEC.
- (7) The contractor shall not block the entrances to the parking lot



ICE CONTROL FOR THE PREVENTION OF SLIPPERY CONDITIONS

- (1) **Ice Control will be determined as necessary by the contractor** and response should start immediately.
- (2) The contractor shall take every reasonable precaution to ensure that slippery conditions on the site are avoided at all times. The contractor shall spread a mixture of sand and salt. **In general this mixture shall be in proportion of one part salt and one part sand.** However, should these amounts and/ or mixtures be found unsatisfactory to adequately control slipping conditions than the amounts and/ or mixtures are to be adjusted accordingly at no extra to JBRSEC.
- (3) It is the contractor's responsibility to ensure that sand and salt is applied in sufficient quantities and with sufficient frequency to prevent slipping conditions at all times. Should the contractor fail to comply with this requirement, he may be held liable for any accidents that occur.
