#### BACKGROUND

#### POLICY STATEMENT

Employees, students, volunteers and visitors are advised of the No Smoking Policy, which includes smoking of tobacco, e-cigarettes or other products that product a vapour or smoke, at the Jack Byrne Sport & Recreation Centre. This includes all areas within in facility.

Any individual(s) smoking in the parking lot must remain at a minimum of 10 meters from all doors and entryways.

POLICY REVIEW: This policy will be reviewed a year after implementation, however, it may be subject to change following new experience or new knowledge.
